On the high road from London to Bath and Bristol. Ecclesiastical parish of 2,927 acres, population 964 in 1871. Tithing in the parish, hundred and union of Bradford.

Vicar: Rev William Laxton MA of Trinity College, Oxford, who lives in Holt; the vicarage is worth £255 in the patronage of the Dean & Chapter of Bristol.

Independent and Baptist chapels.

Lord Methuen is lord of the manor; principal landowner George P. Fuller.
